The AI-Powered Genealogist

Presenter: Andrew Redfern



Artificial Intelligence is rapidly changing the way family historians research, analyze, organize, and share their discoveries. This presentation explores the opportunities, limitations, and emerging role of AI in genealogy, helping researchers understand how these technologies are reshaping the future of family history.

Andrew Redfern, based in Sydney, Australia, is a Director of the Society of Australian Genealogists, where he leads education and technology programs and special interest groups. A sought-after international presenter, Andrew has delivered highly rated sessions on digital skills, technology, and artificial intelligence for family historians at RootsTech, Legacy Family Tree Webinars, the Society of Genealogists (UK), and genealogical societies and libraries across Australia and internationally. In 2026 he was named Technology Volunteer of the Year at the Australian Not-for-Profit Technology Awards, recognizing his voluntary contribution to the NFP sector through technology.
