The author of her own family history book, *The Waters of My Ancestors*, Lynn knows all too well the challenges genealogists face in writing their family history narratives and producing family history books your family will love. Also, Lynn has written a family history children's book, *Maman's Special Job* and a novella about her 3rd great grandfather, *A Journey of Hope, Kilkenny to Canada*.
