Tools for Using Google® to Research Ancestors

The word “Google” is more than a name or a website. It’s become a verb - finding an answer to a question. Beyond its search engine, Google® has many other services such as email, chat, document creation and storage, and location. Many of the services offered by Google® can be used to uncover, record, and even share your family history.

Find out how creating a personal Google® account gives you access to a wide array of online services that can turbo-boost your family history research. It all starts with a Gmail account.

Mitch is a Senior Library Service Specialist with the Clayton Library Center for Genealogical Research. He has been with the Houston Public Library system since early 2017, but his roots in family history go much deeper. Intrigued by a folder of incomplete family group sheets, Mitch began the job of filling in the blanks left by his great-grandfather. This, of course, led to more names and more questions.
