

FOSTER CEMETERY

Apparently a family cemetery at one time. There are only two markers now, and a part of a fence left. The oldest marker is for A.V. Foster, who died 9 January 1892. The cemetery was surveyed by Sammy and Bertice Lee Tise on 21 February 1981.

Go north out of Hallettsville on FM957 to the FM 532 intersection. Turn left and left again at the first road. The cemetery is about 2.5 miles on the right, out in a pasture.

FULLER CEMETERY

This is a small cemetery back off in the woods west of the Navidad River. There are mostly Fuller's buried here and there are 15 markers. There are also 21 unmarked graves. The oldest marker is for Milley Emline Lee, who died 4 May 1903. The cemetery was surveyed by Sammy and Bertice Lee Tise on 2 April 1980.

Go west on 90-A out of Sublime, cross the Navidad River and take the first road to the left. Go until this road tee's into another one and turn right. The cemetery is on the right about 1.3 miles. There is a sign on the gate who to call about getting a key to the cemetery.
